# Circular Economy Managers for SMEs in the Agrifood sector



CEMforSMEs is an Erasmus + project financed by the Portuguese National Agency under the KA2 action in the field of Vocational Education and Training, involving 7 partners from 6 EU countries and running for 24 months.

It aims to create new job opportunities and improve skills for current employeesea, especially in SMEs in the Agrifood sector, through the circular economy model.

#### The project has four main objectives:

- 1. To support the professional development of managers in SMEs to facilitate the transition from the linear to the circular economy
- 2. To foster the development of VET students' competences and the integration ofskills needed for the circular economy
- 3. To develop the professional profile of the circular economy manager and define their role, increasing the quality of job opportunities
- 4. To develop an innovative curriculum with the use of gamification elements to increase skills and establish the certification process of the Circular Economy Manager.
