About the project

The **GreenLift** project supports the green transition of the TCLF sector by providing upskilling and reskilling opportunities for vulnerable and transitioning workers, especially women, NEETs, and those in declining roles, while promoting social inclusion, economic sustainability, and community resilience.

To address the challenges of the green transition, the **GreenLift** project conducted a Transnational Needs Assessment across Sweden, Greece, Italy, and Spain.

Key Insights from the GreenLift Transnational Report

- **Awareness Gaps:** **45%** of respondents reported high familiarity with sustainability concepts in the TCLF sector, highlighting gaps in understanding circular economy and sustainable production practices.
- **Skills Shortages:** **40%** of companies reported a green skills gap, particularly in areas such as eco-design, circular production, and digital technologies.
- **Barriers to Training:** **65%** of the sector's workers cited financial and institutional barriers to sustainability and training, while **30%** pointed to greenwashing as a trust barrier.
- **Training Demand:** **70%** of respondents prefer flexible, hands-on training formats, such as online courses, workshops, and on-the-job learning, to address skills gaps.
